chairs, kitchen, stuffed, rockers, lawn	push lawn mowers (gas, electric or
child car seats	reel - remove gas & oil)
computer components	rugs, rolled up & tied
dry wall, cut up & bundled, boxed or bagged	shop lights
empty barrels (up to 55 gallon)	sinks (bath and kitchen)
end tables	snow blowers
fans, room and ceiling	televisions, table top
fencing and poles (4 ft long or less, tied)	tires, cut in half, limit five(5) per
file cabinets	household
Footlockers	toaster ovens
Footstools	toilets
garden tools	tools, electrical power
Hassocks	vanities
head and foot boards	wash tubs, metal & plastic
heaters, electrical space/room (Not hot water heaters)	water bed bags, empty
lawn spreaders	weight bench and weights
mattress, rolled and tied	wheels, car and trailer
