

### **Neighborhood Clean-Up Guidelines**

All items must be on the curb Saturday morning, November 7th.

Do not put out before 5pm Friday, November 6th. Clean-up is for residents within the boundaries of Moores Park Neighborhood only.

Volunteers are needed to work during clean-up. **NO VOLUNTEERS MEANS NO CLEAN-UP.**

CART trucks will pick up most items as long as they meet these requirements:

- bag, box or bundle loose trash
- items must be less than (4) four feet long and bundled
- mattresses must be rolled and tied, NO box springs
- small furniture, chairs, tables- don't break down, set at curb

#### **Examples of items that will be picked up:**

bed frames  
bicycles  
chairs, stuffed, rockers, lawn  
child car seats  
drywall, cut up & bundled or boxed  
fans  
fencing, 4ft. long or less  
headboards  
pallets  
plastic toys  
rugs, rolled up & tied  
sinks  
televisions, table top  
toilets

#### **Items that will NOT be picked up:**

leaves, grass, branches  
recyclables  
automotive fluids  
freon containing items such as refrigerators, air conditioners  
flammable liquids or tanks  
batteries  
large appliances  
large furniture such as box springs, couches  
wet paint
